KPO's LOCAL CONTENT POLICY

KPO, being one of the leading oil and gas companies in the Republic of Kazakhstan, is committed to support the sustainable development of Kazakhstan and maximize opportunities for Local Content, in accordance with FPSA obligations and the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan

OBJECTIVE

Maximise the use of Goods, Works and Services from Kazakhstan Suppliers at each stage of the procurement process by creating value and opportunities for local Suppliers, provided that procurement from such sources is competitive in terms of price, efficiency, operating parameters, delivery terms and quality

MAJOR DRIVERS
